Where do my kids go?

Drop-off: Our doors will open at 6:20 pm

Please <u>park</u> in the back or side lot and <u>walk your kids</u> to the glass doors on Williams Street for check in. Friends Club <u>and</u> PULSE kids will use the same doors each week.

Pick-up:

Please park in the back or side lot.

A Team Member will come out, ask for your child's name, and bring them to you.

Will there be snacks?

Yes! Snacks will be served regularly and parents will be informed about what the snack is via email.

If your child has an allergy or dietary concern please send an alternative snack.

What are you doing to keep my kids safe?

All Children's Ministries are staffed with trained personnel and regulated by our Child Protection Policy and Procedure.

We will meet or exceed all current CDC Covid protocols which change quickly as you know! Currently, the protocol we are going with is "parents' choice" for masks. If you send your student with a mask, we will make sure they wear it. If you send them without a mask, we will not require them to wear one.
